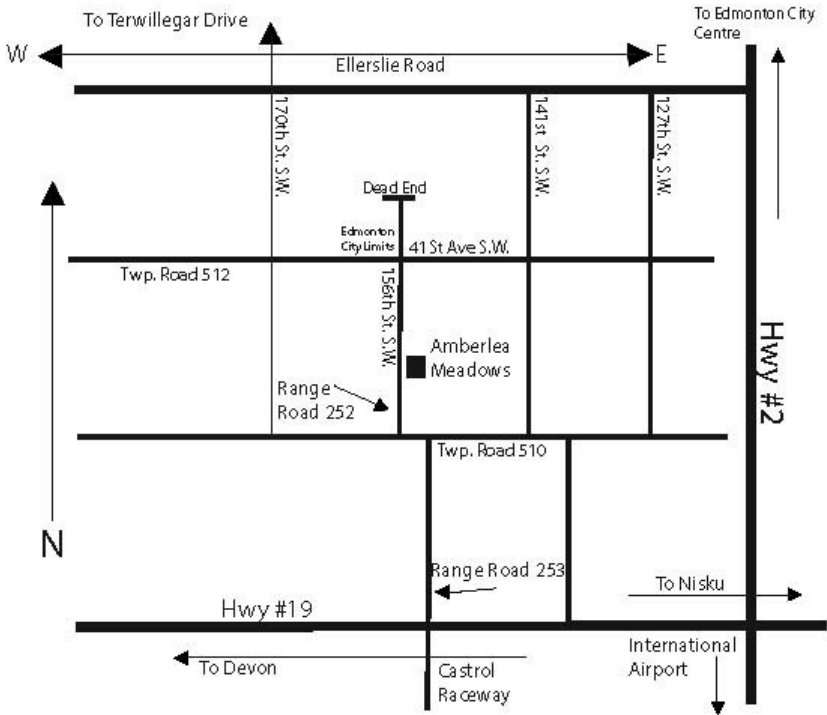

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

1. The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any error or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list. EC rules and regulations will be followed.
2. The management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class not filled to satisfaction; whereupon exhibitors will be notified as soon as possible after close of entries.
3. Inhumane treatment of a horse will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule, at the discretion of the organization committee, will result in disqualification and forfeiture of fees.
4. Any exhibitor using a wrong number, or having no number, may be excused or disqualified from the class, at the judge's discretion.
5. Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, handler or rider, will disqualify the horse, and result in forfeiture of entry fees for subsequent classes. Management reserves the right to remove a groom, handler/ rider and/ or horse from the show, without being liable for compensation.
6. No judge shall be approached with regard to any decision during the time he is judging or is about to judge. Penalty will be disqualification from the show in its entirety.
7. The medical aid fee covers the cost of the medical aid on site. The fee does not cover personal expenses incurred by the injured party in the event of an injury or transportation by ambulance.
8. No person other than officials, staff on duty, and the judges of the classes may enter the competition rings without permission of the tournament management. Competitors are allowed in the competition rings only when competing, when the course is open for walking or during scheduled schooling rounds.
9. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. For safety and sanitary reasons, no dogs will be permitted in the schooling area, show rings or show office.

HARD HATS AND ATTIRE

1. It is mandatory that all persons mounted on a horse anywhere on the competition grounds wear protective headgear secured with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet.
2. ALL persons, including foreign competitors in EC national classes, riding over fences anywhere on the competition grounds MUST wear protective headgear secured with a safety harness affixed to the helmet. It is required that the protective headgear meets the ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) or BSI (British Standard Institution) approved helmets of conservative colour, with safety harness correctly fastened, at all times while mounted on the competition ground. Failure to comply with G102.1 in the exercise area and/or the competition arena will result in the following penalties:
 - 1st violation at competition – warning
 - 2nd violation at the same competition: disqualification from the competition and forfeiture of all fees and prize monies.
3. Junior competitors must wear properly fitted, approved protective headgear, with a safety harness **correctly secured at all times** while mounted on the competition grounds. Approved headgear must be certified by SEI or another testing body that meets the American Society for testing Materials (ASTM) standard or the British Standards Institution (BSI) standard. Juniors not complying with this rule will not be allowed to compete in competitions that require approved headgear. Juniors showing any horse in a jog for soundness must wear approved protective head wear with the attached safety harness fastened.
4. Juniors showing any horse in a jog for soundness must wear approved protective headwear with the attached safety harness fastened
5. We would appreciate a formal turnout.
 - Hunter Ring- braiding and hunt jackets at all times
 - Jumper Ring- (Friday & Saturday)- Collared shirts (ie polo shirts) are allowed
 - (Sunday)- Hunt jackets are required

HORS CONCOURS

Hors Concours Pertaining to Jumpers -Article G501

“Hors Concours” entries maybe accepted at the competition committee’s discretion but are subject to the same rules as a regular entry.

“Hors Concours” may not participate in any jump off.

A horse or pony that has competed “Hors Concours” is not allowed to compete subsequently in the same ring on the same day.

Hors Concours Pertaining to Hunter Classes - Article G201

No Horse or pony will be allowed to show "Hors Concours" in hunter classes or divisions.

ENTRIES

1. Payment must be made in full including GST. Please make cheques payable to Amberlea Meadows. NSF fee of \$30.00 will be charged.
2. Entry forms **MUST** be signed. A parent/legal guardian must sign for juniors. A trainers signature is not valid. No numbers will be released without the required signatures.
3. Late entries may be accepted up to the date of the show, subject to the approval of the show management and must be accompanied with payment of a \$50.00 late fee.
4. Substitutions and Transfer of entries.
There will be **NO** office charge per add/scratch sheet if done the day before the competition starts for horses already entered prior to the closing date. All changes must be made no later than ½ hour after the last class of the day. Late and same day changes will be charged \$10.00 per class/division. Any Exhibitor who does not compete in a class(es) in which the exhibitor is officially entered, and does not scratch according to the scratch procedure will be billed for the class(es). You **MUST** do your paperwork in the Show Office to avoid this penalty.
5. Please list your coach's name on the entry form, if you ride with one, to facilitate the draws for class order.
6. In the event of disability of a horse, 75% of entry fees will be refunded upon presentation of a veterinary certificate before the show commences on Friday morning. No refunds after the commencement of the first class of the show. **Stabling, medical aid, and or administration fees are non-refundable.**

STABLING

1. ****NEW**** Two different levels of stabling will be available for the show for all competitors. Heated indoor stabling in the A-barn will be available on a first come first serve basis for \$150 + GST for the duration of the show. Stabling will also be available in the show barn for \$125 +GST. In the event of inclement weather diesel heaters will be provided in the show barn.
2. Feed and bedding is available for sale from the show office.

3. No horse will be placed in an unassigned stall without approval from management.

4. Stabling will be available from 12:00 pm April 22 and must be vacated at the end of the competition on April 25.

TROPHIES, RIBBONS AND PRIZE MONEY

1. **Champion and Reserve Champion** will be named in all divisions.

Points will be awarded to 6th place based on the following system:

As per ARTICLE G204 HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIPS

1st	7 points	2nd	5 points	3rd	4 points
4th	3 points	5th	2 points	6th	1 point

Jumper Championship: The Champion and Reserve Champion titles shall be awarded to the two horses that have accumulated the most points performing over fences in the division in which they are being shown. In the case of a tie for the championship there may be a jump-off after the last jumping class of the competition. Exhibitors tied for Champion or reserve may elect to jump-off or toss a coin.

Hunter Championship: The Champion and Reserve Champion titles shall be awarded to two of the four horses that have accumulated the most points performing over fences in the division in which they are being shown. In addition to these points, only these four horses shall receive points for ribbons won in the under saddle class. In the case of a tie, the Championship and/or Reserve shall be awarded to the horse that has accumulated the most points over fences. In the event there is still a tie, the tied horses shall be shown at walk, trot, and canter to determine championship and reserve. This competition shall be judged as an independent Hunter Under Saddle class with conformation, quality, substance, soundness and performance to count as prescribed throughout the appropriate division. Tossing a coin to break the tie is permissible if all participants agree.

2. Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place, placing to 8th

Ribbons will be awarded to 8th place in Medal classes.

Prizes will also be awarded to the winner of each class.

3. Championship Awards will be made to the Champion and Reserve Champion of each Hunter and Jumper Division.

-Each Hunter Division will have \$100 awarded in the stake class to 4th.

Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place (ASJA qualifying classes will be placed to 8th for points).

-Each Jumper division will have \$200 awarded in the stake class to 4th

Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place (ASJA qualifying classes will be placed to 8th for points).

4. Prize money will be paid out in a stake class as follows:

1st 40%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%, 4th 10%

To enter a stake class, a horse must have been shown, and judged, in at least one class over fences in the respective division.

SCHOOLING ROUNDS

1. Hunter and jumper schooling rounds will be available (weather permitting) from 10:00 am until 8:00 pm on Thursday, April 22/10. (Times may change slightly, subject to demand.) **Trainers may book block times by calling the show office in advance at 780-955-7608. Any trainers blocks with less than 8 clients maybe combined with another group. Combined group sizes will be limited to a maximum of 10 wherever possible.**

Individual rounds may also be booked at the in gate. All competitors wishing to school must have a schooling pass.

Schooling Round Pass:

Purchase of a schooling round pass, will enable the horse to participate in unlimited schooling rounds in any of the rings during the schooling times. The schooling round pass must be presented each time the horse enters the ring. The horse must have its competitions number on. Pass price \$25.00 per horse.

2. Only horses entered into a minimum of one division in the tournament are eligible to participate in schooling rounds.

3. **Schooling classes** will also be offered on Friday a.m. in the hunter ring and Friday a.m. and Saturday a.m. in the jumper ring.

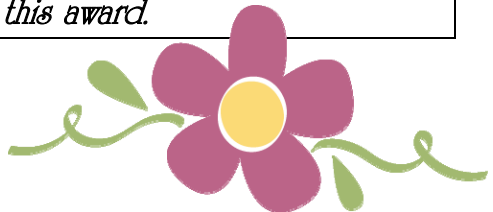


RV PARKING

An Open Numerical scoring system must be used in the 1st round with each riders score announced at the completion of their round. Any rider that has competed over fences at a height of 1.30m or higher is not eligible for the Childrens or Adult hunter medals. Riders may not cross enter between ASJA Medals at the same show. Riders who “move up” to higher medals will only acquire points in the highest division they have competed in.
