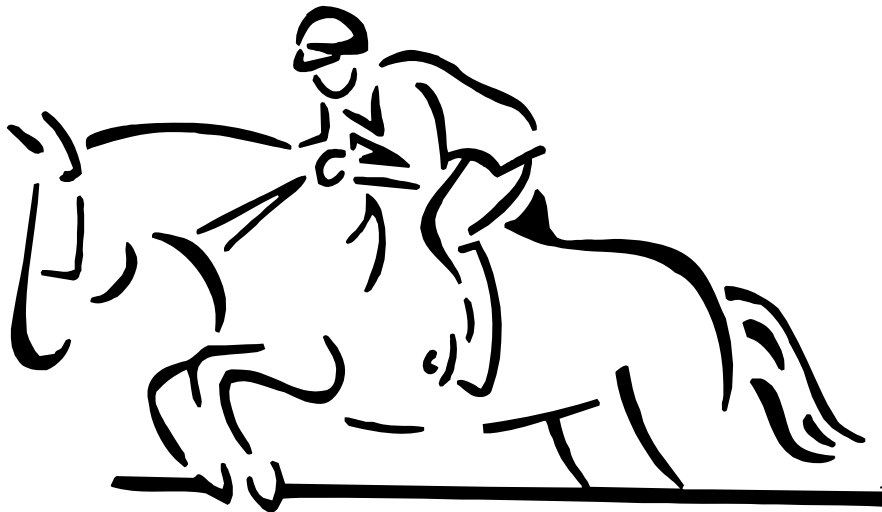

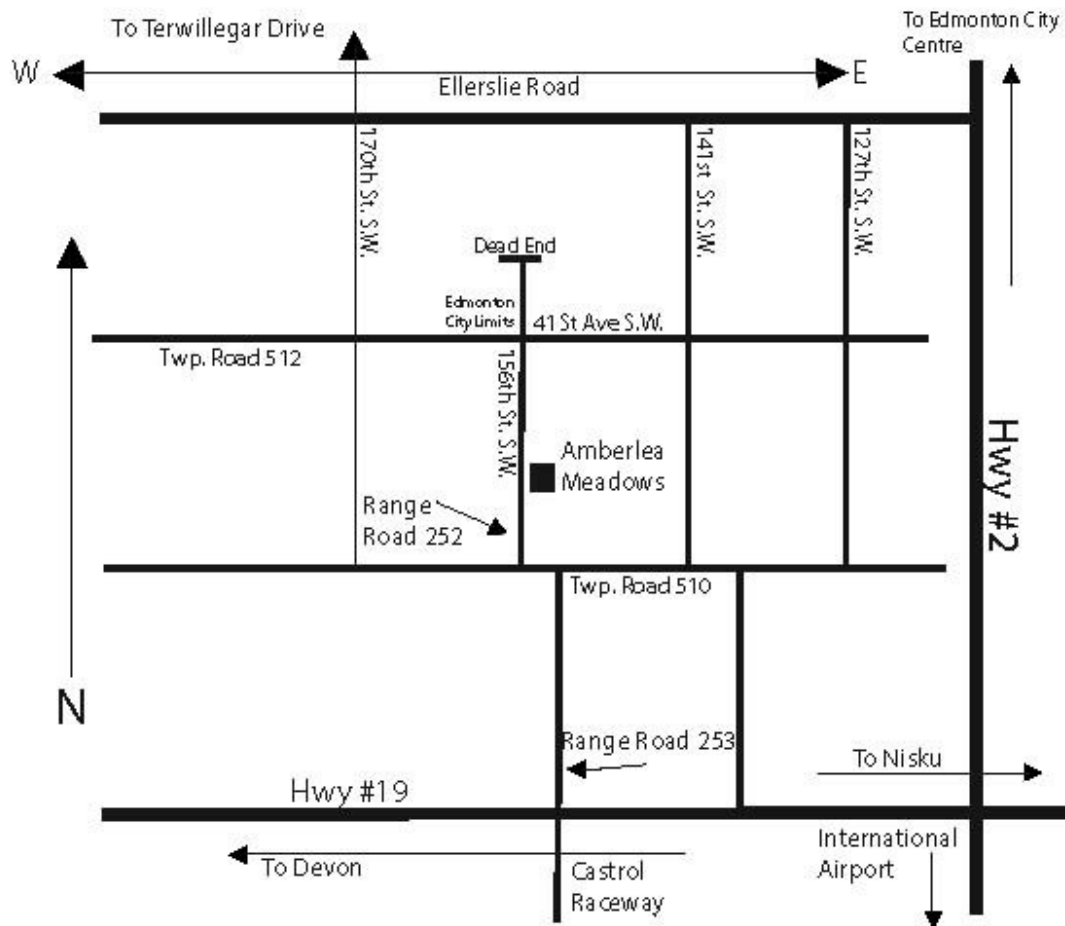

All Memberships/licenses must be in compliance with the level of show:
Please note that EC membership is required to enter the show. Any competitors that do not have an EC Bronze competitive sport license may apply at the show for Temporary sport license.

Passports – Not required.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

1. The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any error or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list. EC rules and regulations will be followed.
2. The management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class not filled to satisfaction; whereupon exhibitors will be notified as soon as possible after close of entries.
3. Inhumane treatment of a horse will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule, at the discretion of the organization committee, will result in disqualification and forfeiture of fees.
4. Any exhibitor using a wrong number, or having no number, may be excused or disqualified from the class, at the judge's discretion.
5. Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, handler or rider, will disqualify the horse, and result in forfeiture of entry fees for subsequent classes. Management reserves the right to remove a groom, handler/ rider and/ or horse from the show, without being liable for compensation.
6. No judge shall be approached with regard to any decision during the time he is judging or is about to judge. Penalty will be disqualification from the show in its entirety.
7. The medical aid fee covers the cost of the medical aid on site. The fee does not cover personal expenses incurred by the injured party in the event of an injury or transportation by ambulance.
8. No person other than officials, staff on duty, and the judges of the classes may enter the competition rings without permission of the tournament management. Competitors are allowed in the competition rings only when competing, when the course is open for walking or during scheduled schooling rounds.
9. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. For safety and sanitary reasons, no dogs will be permitted in the schooling area, show rings or show office.

HARD HATS AND ATTIRE

1. It is mandatory that all persons mounted on a horse anywhere on the competition grounds wear protective headgear secured with a safety harness permanently affixed to the helmet.

2. ALL persons, including foreign competitors in EC national classes, riding over fences anywhere on the competition grounds **MUST** wear protective headgear secured with a safety harness affixed to the helmet. It is required that the protective headgear meets the ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) or BSI (British Standard Institution) approved helmets of conservative colour, with safety harness correctly fastened, at all times while mounted on the competition ground. Failure to comply with G102.1 in the exercise area and/or the competition arena will result in the following penalties:

- 1st violation at competition – warning
- 2nd violation at the same competition: disqualification from the competition and forfeiture of all fees and prize monies.

3. Junior competitors must wear properly fitted, approved protective headgear, with a safety harness **correctly secured at all times** while mounted on the competition grounds. Approved headgear must be certified by SEI or another testing body that meets the American Society for testing Materials (ASTM) standard or the British Standards Institution (BSI) standard. Juniors not complying with this rule will not be allowed to compete in competitions that require approved headgear.

HORS CONCOURS

Hors Concours Pertaining to Jumpers -Article G601

“Hors Concours” entries maybe accepted at the competition committee’s discretion but are subject to the same rules as a regular entry.

“Hors Concours” may not participate in any jump off.

Hors Concours entries will follow the last regular entry in the class.

A horse or pony that has competed “Hors Concours” is not allowed to compete subsequently in the same ring on the same day.

Hors Concours Pertaining to Hunter Classes - Article G501

No Horse or pony will be allowed to show “Hors Concours” in hunter classes or divisions.

ENTRIES

1. Payment must be made in full including GST, for each horse entered an open cheque or credit card number must accompany the completed entry form. Numbers will not be issued without a cheque or credit card number to cover the balance. Please make cheques payable to Amberlea Meadows. A fee of \$30.00 will be charged for any NSF cheques.

2. Entry forms **MUST** be signed. A parent/legal guardian must sign for juniors. A trainers signature is not valid. No numbers will be released without the required signatures.

3. Late entries may be accepted up to the date of the show, subject to the approval of the show management and must be accompanied with payment of a \$25.00 late fee.

4. Substitutions and Transfer of entries.

There will be **NO** office charge per add/scratch sheet if done the day before the competition starts for horses already entered prior to the closing date. All changes must be made no later than ½ hour after the last class of the day. Late and same day changes will be charged \$10.00 per class/division. Any Exhibitor who does not compete in a class(es) in which the exhibitor is officially entered, and does not scratch according to the scratch procedure will be bill for the class(es). You **MUST** do your paperwork in the Show Office to avoid this penalty.

5. Please list your coach's name on the entry form, if you ride with one, to facilitate the draws for class order.

STABLING

1. Stabling is mandatory at Amberlea Meadows for all competitors at a rate of \$45.00 a night or \$35.00 for a day stall. Tack stalls are available.

2. Feed and bedding is available for sale from the show office.

3. No horse will be placed in an unassigned stall without approval from management.

SCHOOLING ROUNDS

1. Hunter and jumper schooling rounds will be available 6:30-8:50am. (Times may change slightly, subject to demand.) Schooling round times may be booked in blocks for stables (30 minute block times.) Please call the office at 955-7608 to book a 'block time'. Individual rounds may also be booked at the in gate. Warm ups will also be available prior to each division as stated in the tentative schedule. In the interest of safety, the number of horses in the arena at any one time will be limited, as will time allocated to each horse for warm up.

It is understood that under no circumstances shall Amberlea Stables Ltd., nor the owners, management, tournament committee, nor any of its staff or agents be liable for any loss, damages, claims or costs as a result of Amberlea Stables Ltd., nor the owners, management, tournament committee, nor any of its staff or agents, negligence, and that you agree to indemnify and save harmless Amberlea Stables Ltd., nor the owners, management, tournament committee, nor any of its staff or agents from and against any and all liability arising out of such loss, damages, claims or costs.

ASJA MEDAL CLASSES

Memberships required for ASJA

To Fill a class three competitors must compete in the class. Testing of a minimum of the top 4 competitors over fences is required to return for a ride-off. Riders return in the same tack they jumped in the first phase.

An Open Numerical scoring system must be used in the 1st round with each riders score announced at the completion of their round. Any rider that has competed over fences at a height of 1.30m or higher is not eligible for the Children's or Adult hunter medals. Riders may not cross enter between ASJA Medals at the same show. Riders who "move up" to higher medals will only acquire points in the highest division they have competed in.

At present time we are not offering a medal for ASJA Short Long Stirrup (2'3"), ASJA Short Stirrup Pony (2'3") ASJA Modified Child/Adult (2'9) or ASJA Modified Junior/Amateur (3'3) however if enough interest is generated we will offer these medals please contact the show office.

Amberlea Poles & Crosspoles Medal & Novice Rider Medal will be point collectors for ASJA Members.

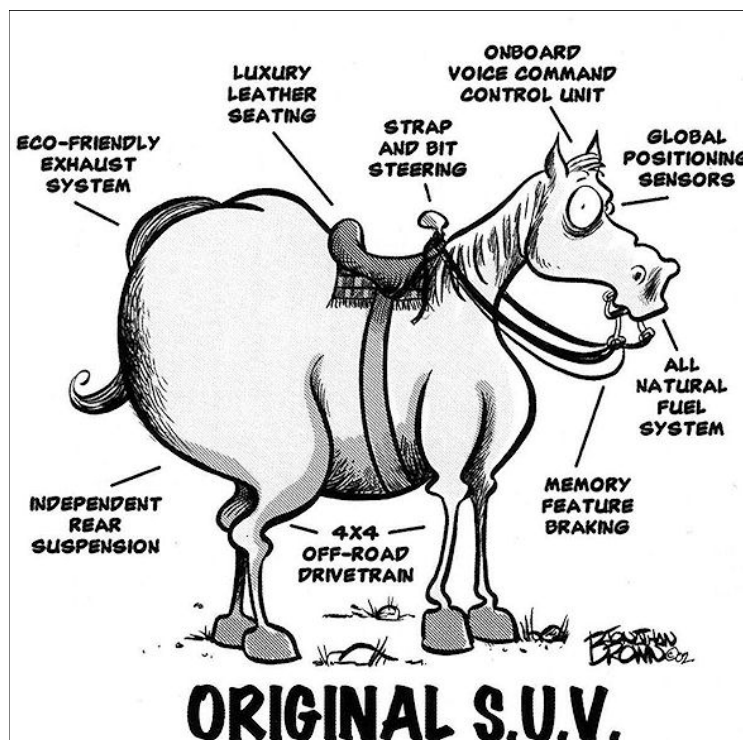
