The changes began right after the Harvest Show and well before our first serious snowfall. Trees were planted along the fence line and perimeter of the new grass jumper ring which is located east of the grand prix ring. These trees will become a nice barrier to the elements as time goes on.

The outdoor sand ring was graded and resurfaced in preparation for the 2014 Spring season.

In addition, the indoor arena footing will be changed in the near future to GGT footing.

GGT is a polypropylene fibre that is blended with sand to help bind the footing providing cushion, traction and shear support. We are excited about the changes and look forward to the improvements they will bring to your horses.

Glossary of Horse Terms We can all relate to some of these
