- All Memberships/licenses must be in compliance with the level of show:
- AEF 2026 Membership is required to enter this show.
- Passports/Horse recording are not required.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

1. The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any error or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list. AEF / EC rules and regulations will be followed.
2. The management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class not filled to satisfaction; whereupon exhibitors will be notified as soon as possible after close of entries.
3. Management reserves the right to change the class order, if necessary, after the close of entries. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to determine when their classes will be judged.
4. **Inhumane treatment of a horse will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule, at the discretion of the organization committee, will result in disqualification and forfeiture of fees.**
5. Any exhibitor using a wrong number, or having no number, may be excused or disqualified from the class, at the judge's discretion.
6. Exhibitors are responsible for reporting all entries to the gate attendant before each respective class is called. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to determine when their class will be judged. A gate hold will prevail as a courtesy only
7. There will be NO office charge per add/scratch sheet if done the day before the competition starts for horses already entered prior to the closing date. **All changes must be made by 4:00pm.** Late and same day changes will be charged \$10.00 per class/division. Any Exhibitor who does not compete in a class(es) in which the exhibitor is officially entered and does not scratch according to the scratch procedure will be billed for the class(es). Trainers only – Trainers will be allowed to do add/scratch sheets in office. Trainer's sheets will be available, Trainer Add/scratch sheets MUST be completed by 4:00 in order to facilitate order of go. **If you are an individual without trainer a please contact office the via email, phone or through horseshowtime.com.**
8. Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, handler or rider, will disqualify the horse, and result in forfeiture of entry fees for subsequent classes. Management reserves the right to remove a groom, handler/ rider and/ or horse from the show, without being liable for compensation.
9. No judge shall be approached regarding any decision during the time he is judging or is about to judge. Penalty will be disqualification from the show in its entirety.
10. The medical aid fee covers the cost of the medical aid on site. The fee does not cover personal expenses incurred by the injured party in the event of an injury or transportation by ambulance.
11. No person other than officials, staff on duty, and the judges of the classes may enter the competition rings without permission of the tournament management. Competitors are allowed in the competition rings only when competing, when the course is open for walking or during scheduled schooling rounds.
12. Dogs must always be on a leash.
13. "Any person who wishes to ride a horse anywhere on the Showgrounds during the duration of the show must sign a waiver prior to getting on the horse. Waivers are available in the show office"

HORS CONCOURS

Hors Concours Pertaining to Jumpers -Article G501

1. Horses shall be allowed to compete "Hors Concours" with permission from the organizing committee but are subject to the same scoring rules as a regular entry with respect to falls, elimination etc. Such entries are not judged and are not eligible for the jump off.
2. A horse or pony that has competed "Hors Concours" is not allowed to compete subsequently in the same ring on the same day.
3. "Hors Concours" entries will follow the last regular entry in the class.
4. "Hors Concours" entries are not allowed in Hunter Divisions, Equitation and Medal classes.

EQUINE VACCINATION RULE

“All horses attending sanctioned competitions must have met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article A519. **VACCINATIONS** All horses attending competitions must have been administered Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes Virus (1 and 4) vaccinations within six (6) months (+21 days grace period) before arrival at the competition. No horse shall have received vaccination within seven (7) days prior to arrival at the event. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be asked to leave event site at the discretion of competition management. The frequency of vaccine administration should be as recommended by the vaccine manufacturer or veterinarian. It is recommended that vaccines be administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian. Competition management may request supporting documentation confirming a horse’s compliance with mandatory vaccination requirements. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccines, a letter must be provided with the entry form from a veterinarian, on official letterhead, stating the equine cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns. At the discretion of competition management, a log of the horse’s temperature prior to arrival at the event site or during the event can be requested

Requirement for horses entering show grounds:

Proof of Vaccination is mandatory for EHV-1&4 and Equine Influenza. Records from a veterinarian must be submitted to showoffice@amberleameadows.com prior to arrival at the show grounds.

PRIZE LIST MANDATORY INFORMATION

1. At all competitions, anyone mounted on a horse, including foreign competitors, must wear ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) or BSI approved helmets, with safety harness correctly fastened, at all times while mounted on the competition grounds. **ARTICLE G102 HEADGEAR**
2. Juniors showing any horse in a jog for soundness must wear approved protective headwear with the attached safety harness fastened.

MEMBERSHIPS

Riders must be Alberta Equestrian Federation members.

No passport required

RV PARKING

Campers or motorhomes are to be parked in the southwest parking lot by the arena, where plug-ins are available for \$150/ weekend + GST. No RV’s with propane tanks will be allowed to park within 50 feet of any building to avoid potential fire risk. Showers are available for public use in the main barn area. A septic tank dumping station is also available for use. Please make a note on entry form if you are requiring RV parking.

HAUL-INS

The haul-in fee per horse is \$45 (day) plus GST **per day or \$100 per week . The haul in fee per horse will be charged if horse is not stabled.** Trailer and haul in parking permitted in the parking lot across from the horse show office.

STABLING

1. Two different levels of stabling will be available for the show for all competitors. Heated indoor stabling in the A-barn will be available on a first come first serve basis for \$230 + GST for the duration of the show. Stabling will also be available in the show barn for \$200 +GST. Day stall \$95.00 plus gst. (Stabling will include 3 bags of shavings per stall) \$30 Environmental fee per entry Effective in 2026, all stabling will have an environmental fee attached. This fee is to cover the cost of the disposal of the manure.
2. **Feed and bedding should be pre-ordered there will be limited bedding or feed deliveries during show. Competitors asked to pre-order bedding on entry form. Limited deliveries available during show.**
3. No horse will be placed in an unassigned stall without approval from management.
4. Stabling will be available from April 23 and must be vacated at the end of the competition on April 26.

- Add's & Scratches are due into the office by 5pm daily
- All rings will be in Sand rings/no grass

ENTRIES

1. All competitors will be required to include credit card information on entry forms. Accounts may be settled via E-transfer, Debit, Cash, Cheque or Credit Card. Credit Card transactions will incur a 3.5% processing fee
2. Entry forms MUST be signed. A parent/legal guardian must sign for juniors. A trainer's signature is not valid. No numbers will be released without the required signatures.
3. Late entries may be accepted up to the date of the show, subject to the approval of the show management. Entries received after the closing date will be subject to a \$50.00 late fee.
4. Please list your coach's name on the entry form, if you ride with one, to facilitate the draws for class order.
5. Cancellations prior to the closing date (April 14) will have all fees less the Administration Fee refunded. Cancellations after the closing date (April 14) with a veterinary certificate or medical certificate will have stabling fees, and 50% of the class fees refunded. Cancellations after the closing date (April 15) without a veterinary certificate or medical certificate will have stabling fees, refunded. Administration and class fees will not be refunded. Cancellations after April 14 will forfeit all fees. Substitutions will be permitted, prior to the start of the show, for a fee of \$25.00.

HUNTER SCHOOLING ROUNDS

Hunter schooling pass **will be available (weather permitting) from 10:00 am until 6:00 pm on Thursday, April 23/26. (Times may change slightly, subject to demand.)** Trainers may book block times by calling the show office in advance at 780-955-7608 or email showoffice@amberleameadows.com Any trainer's blocks with less than 8 clients maybe combined with another group. Combined group sizes will be limited to a maximum of 10. Individual rounds may also be booked at the in-gate. **All competitors wishing to school must have purchased a schooling pass.**

Schooling Round:

1. Purchase of a schooling pass will enable the horse to participate in unlimited schooling rounds in the hunter ring during the schooling times. The horse must have its competitions number on. Pass price \$40.00 per horse.
2. Only horses entered in the tournament are eligible to participate in schooling rounds.

NON COMPETING HORSE

There will be a non-showing fee of \$50 for horses per day not entered in any competitions at the tournament. The non-showing fee allows use of the warm-up rings and other grounds as well as access to the rings on warm-up day. All riders of non-showing horses are required to sign an entry waiver and wear a number while on the grounds.

Fences to 2'6". Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 2'9". The same horse must be used in all phases.

Class 504 Modified Child/Adult Hunter Medal 2'9"

Open to Jr/Am horse/rider combinations where the rider does not jump higher than 3' at the same competition.

Class 505 Child/Adult Hunter Medal - Fences to 3'-0"

Open to all Junior/Adult Amateur riders who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one horse per rider. No cross entry into Pony Medal at the same show.

Class 506 0.80 Amberlea Jumper Medal

Fences to .80m Open to junior/amateur riders. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one horse per rider. No cross entry to other jumper medals over .90m.

Class 507 On the Hunt Eq 0.90m Jumper Medal

Fences to 0.90m. Open to junior/amateur riders. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one horse per rider. No cross entry to other jumper medals over 1.0m.

Class 508 Eclipse Equestrian 1.00m Jumper Medal

First phase to be shown over a jumper style course with a minimum of 10 fences .90-1.0m in height. An open numerical scoring system is used in the first phase with each rider's score announced. Second phase will involve a minimum of 4 riders to a maximum of 8 riders. No tack change is permitted between phases. The winner will be determined by the combined score of both phases.


Class 509 Eclipse Equestrian 1.10m Jumper Medal First phase to be shown over a jumper style course with a minimum of 10 fences 1.10m in height. An open numerical scoring system is used in the first phase with each rider's score announced. Second phase will involve a minimum of 4 riders to a maximum of 8 riders. No tack change is permitted between phases. Rides may not have guidance from trainers for second phase. The winner will be determined by the combined score of both phases.
